- 1. “If an evangelist would be as *inaccurate* in his statements regarding the *need* of a lost sinner for a Savior, the work of that Savior on the Cross, & *the way* a sinner must appropriate that salvation, as we allow ourselves to be when we teach the saints about the ministry of the Holy Spirit, how many souls would be saved?”
- *not many!*

- 2. It is the clear, simple, accurate, true to the Word statements of the evangelist which the Holy Spirit uses.
- 3. And If lost souls would be kept from salvation by a message which does not accurately explain the way of salvation, then saints are being deprived of the most efficient ministry of the Holy Spirit because of the **obscurities & inaccuracies** so prevalent in much of the teaching regarding His Person & work. & **how to be Filled with the Holy Spirit & by the Holy Spirit.**
