John presents Jesus Christ as God

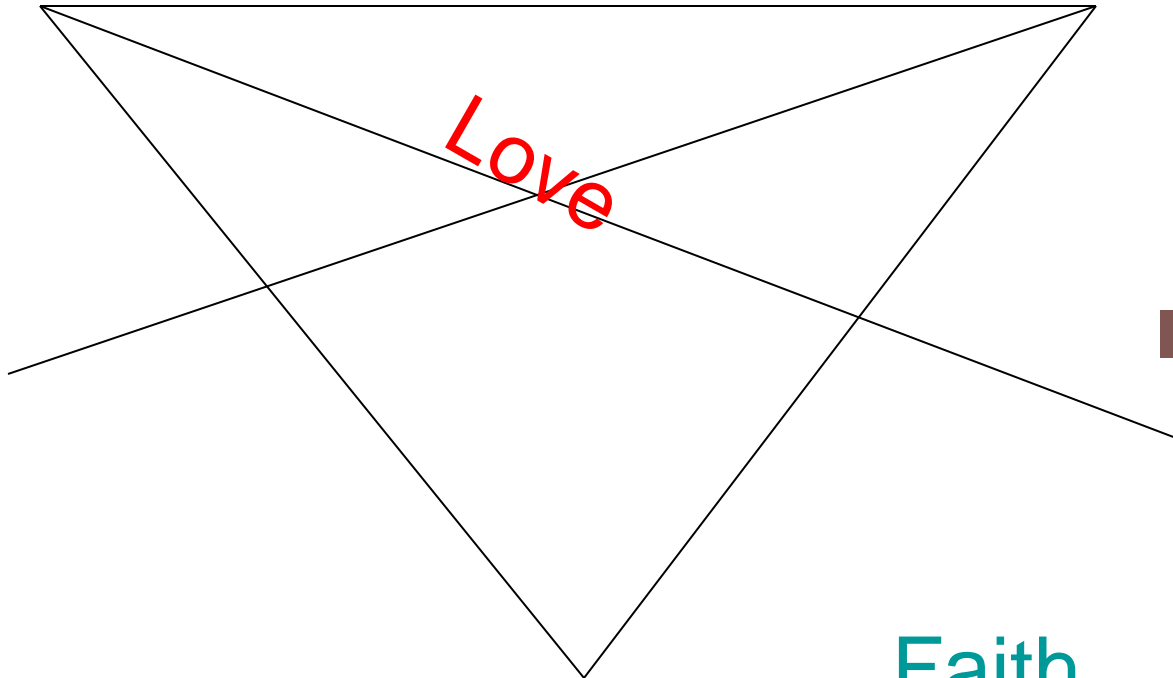
How can one be both God and man in one person?
